2011 OPERATIONNAL BUDGETS

SCHEDULE FOR THE EQUALIZATION OF TAX RATES

2011 -006 Mr. Martin Albert moves that the schedule for the equalization of tax rates in Edmundston adopted January 16th, 2006 be modified and that the adjustment period to obtain the equalization of the common tax rates be modified to a period not exceeding 2014.

GENERAL OPERATIONNAL FUNDS

2011 -007 Mr. Jean Guy Marquis moves that the municipality of Edmundston accepts the sum of 25,855,672\$ be the total budget of the municipality for the year 2011, that the sum of 19,161,087\$ be the warrant of the municipality, and that the tax rates be as follows:

\$1.6250 per \$100 of assessment for Zone 1/Edmundston

\$1.3730 per \$100 of assessment for Zone 2/Saint-Jacques

\$1.5867 per \$100 of assessment for Zone 3/Saint-Basile

\$1.6250 per \$100 of assessment for Zone 4/Verret

\$1.3145 per \$100 of assessment for Zone 5/ Mad. LSD

The Council orders and directs the levying by the Minister of Local Government of said amount on real property liable to taxation under the Assessment Act within the municipality of Edmundston.

WATER AND SEWER UTILITY FUND
